

# Purpose of the Port Ludlow Village Council

The *Port Ludlow Village Council* is a non-profit, tax-exempt corporation.

The purpose of the Council is to be a unifying force in the community: to identify issues of importance, to formulate a consensus of opinion among residents, merchants and developers, and to represent those community interests to the public as well as to government entities. The Council may also:

- Acquire by donation, lease or purchase real estate properties, facilities and services such as public utilities, and may operate and improve them.
- Engage in architectural oversight of areas not under the jurisdiction of South Bay Community Association (SBCA) or Ludlow Maintenance Commission (LMC).
- Construct, preserve, and maintain outdoor recreational areas such as trails, lakes, wildlife habitats, greenbelts and wilderness reserves.

The twelve-member, “non-paid” Board of Directors consists of ten elected residents and two appointed residents representing the SBCA and LMC. Council members serve 2 year terms, 1/2 of the Board being elected each year.

## Community Development:

Reviews development plans within Port Ludlow Master Planned Resort and act as the liaison between the community and Jefferson County government.

Recycling services are provided for the community in conjunction with Port Ludlow Associates.

## Natural Resources & Trails:

Develops and maintains a first-class 15-mile pedestrian trail system within Port Ludlow.

## Community Directory:

Create, update and publish the Port Ludlow Directory – a directory of residents and businesses serving the Port Ludlow community.

## Utilities:

Monitors operation of utilities and presents alternatives for the future to the Council and the community.

The Port Ludlow Village Council is undertaking the following projects and activities during the 2008-2009 term:

1. Monitoring Iron Mt. Quarry activities and applications.
2. Continue updating the Port Ludlow Directory for publication.
3. Continue activities relating to defining the concept of a "One Port Ludlow."
4. Revitalize the Community Development Committee.
5. Continue updating the PLVC by-laws.
6. Create a communications system for dispersing urgent news to all residents.
7. Establish a Public Relations Committee to promote the value of the PLVC.
