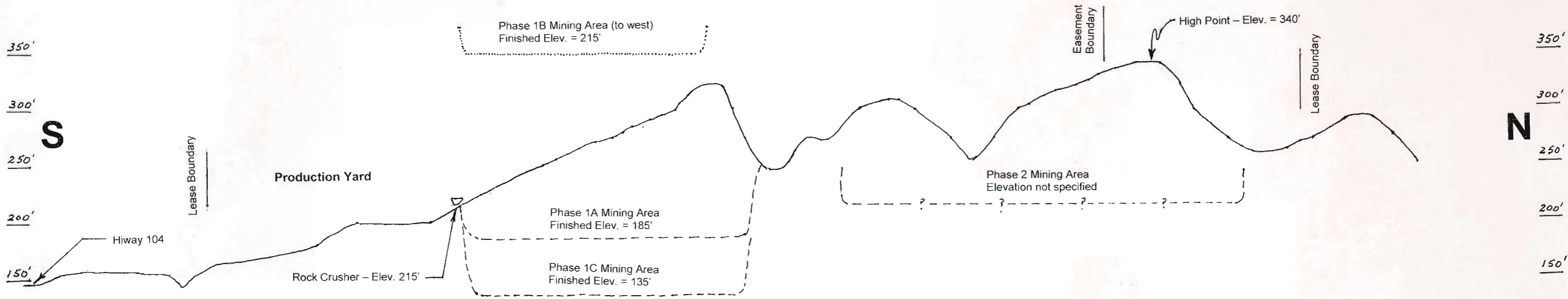


Topographic Profile, Proposed Iron Mountain Quarry



Explanatory Statement

The colored contours on the map outline the highest areas within the IMQ lease. Red is 300 feet; orange is 325 feet. The North-South topographic profile across the area shows that this high area will provide a sound barrier that will protect Port Ludlow during most of the earlier stages of quarrying. Under the present proposal this barrier would be destroyed in the later stages of quarrying.
